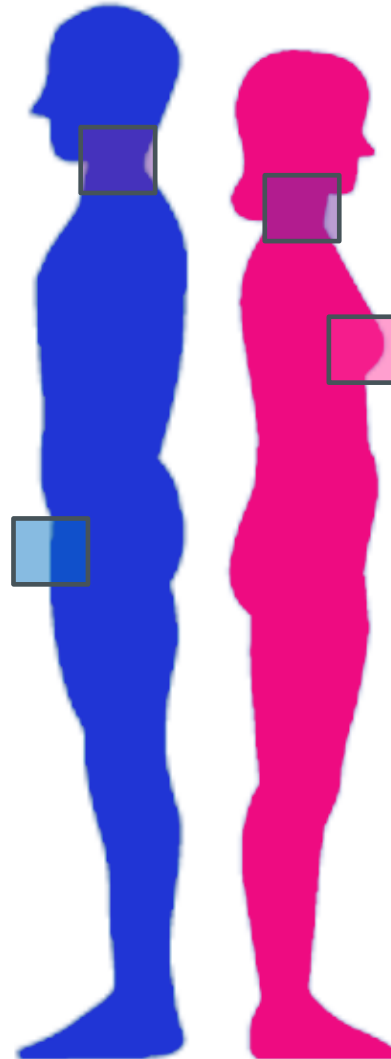


CANCER BODY MAP

Prostate Cancer – Accounts for 17.8% of all cancer diagnoses

- Most diagnosed cancer in men
- 20-30% of patients will show recurrence following androgen-directed treatment
- Treatment options: anti-androgens, chemical castration, radical prostatectomy, radiation brachytherapy



Thyroid Cancer – Accounts for 5% of cancer diagnosis

- 4:1 higher prevalence in females vs. males
- Papillary Thyroid Cancer accounts for ~90% of all thyroid cancer
- Up to 20% recurrence rates for papillary thyroid cancer
- Treatment options, Complete thyroidectomy followed by life-time levothyroxine (Synthroid®)

HER2+ Breast Cancer – Accounts for 19.4% of all cancer diagnosis

- Most diagnosed cancer in women
- HER2+ account for 20% of all breast cancers
- Up to 30% will relapse following Trastuzumab treatment
- Treatment options, Trastuzumab and mastectomy
